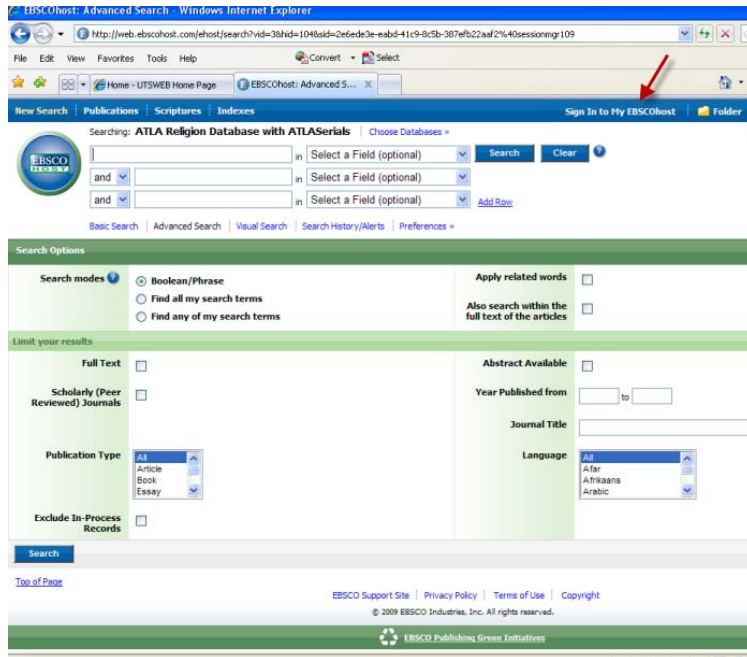

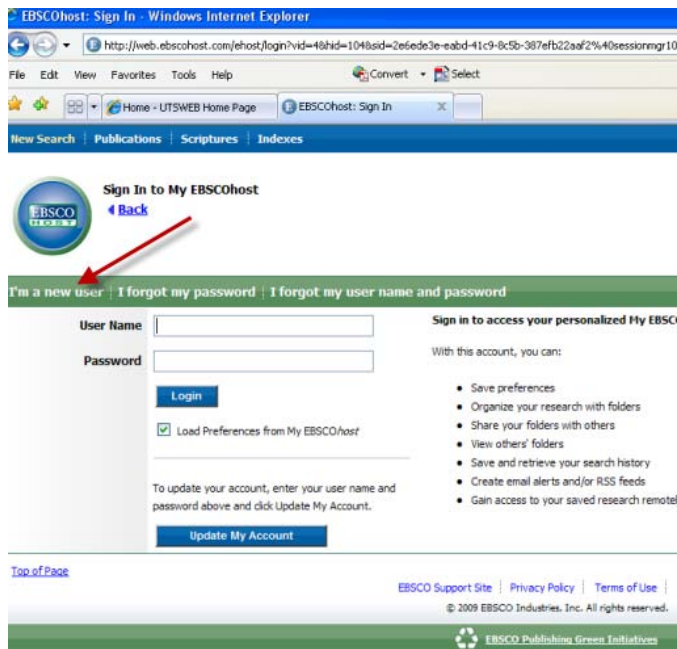

How to create a “MY EBSCOhost Account” by clicking “**sign in to my EBSCOhost**”
This account will allow you to save you research and go back to it time and time again, if you remember your Username and Password.



Click on **I'm a new user**



Add your information **BUT**, when you come to the User Name and Password use your **UTS** user name and password. NOTE: If you don't use your UTS user name and password **EBSCO does not have anyone**

to help you, if you forget the one you used. You will lose all of the information you have saved in your search area, if you don't remember this username and password. EX. Username = ghoskins Password Pword111.

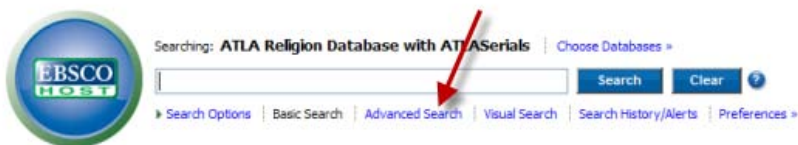
